Visas and COVID-19

We're falling back into a semi-normal rhythm again! Fall and spring semesters of 2022-2023 will return to their pre-pandemic length, around 110 days. The extended length means students will once again need to obtain a Schengen visa to participate in our fall and spring semester programing. Students can opt to participate in our group visa appointment or can work through the process on their own.

New Course: SIS 321

Advanced Conversation & Oral Expression

During Summer 2021, we surveyed a few of you, our wonderful partners, regarding courses that you think would be valuable for your students while abroad. The majority of you suggested students would benefit from a conversation course. As a common requirement for a Spanish minor/major, it is a welcome addition to our course offerings starting in Fall 2022.

Students will apply Spanish language skills in a variety of social settings to improve oral expression and pronunciation, acquire a more extensive vocabulary, and increase fluency. Through audio visual media, presentations, and dramatizations, the student will have the opportunity to express their ideas using Spanish and receive extensive feedback.
