Many students were able to serve with *Acción Solidaria* (our service-learning class), got involved in local churches, and some students even stayed an extra six-weeks to complete a three-credit (120 hour) internship. Our students, faculty, staff, and host families were able to form meaningful relationships which made for a hard goodbye. However, it was exciting to end the semester with the *Feria de Sevilla*, where students were able to dance *Sevillanas* (pictured above) with the locals.

Our summer terms also brought in a large and enthusiastic group of students. The summer included intensive classes, exciting excursions to *Ronda* and *Córdoba*, internships in the second term, a visit to the NAO Victoria, and three-day weekends for our students to make the most of their time getting immersed in Spain! The summer terms included not only students, but a partner school visit called "See Ya in *Sevilla*." We welcomed faculty and staff from Baylor University, Spring Arbor University, Anderson University (SC), and Westmont College, representing the north, south, east, and west of the United States! Our visitors were able to attend classes alongside students, visit *Encuentro* (our weekly worship event) explore *Sevilla* and *Córdoba*, and spend quality time with our faculty and staff truly getting to know the ins and outs of SIS.

Nuevas oportunidades: Verano de 2024

Service-Learning: Are your students looking for a summer service opportunity? Upon completion of Summer Term 1, students can participate in our service-learning program (known as *Acción Solidaria*) with a Sevillian NGO during Term 2. Students will meet regularly with TCCSevilla staff to reflect on their service experience for further spiritual and intercultural development in a classroom setting as well as complete a final presentation. This is a four-credit course offering 80 hours on-site.

High School Summer Groups: Do you know of any private high school teachers wanting to take a group to Spain? Starting next summer, we will offer a two-week summer experience called *Verano Sevillano*. High schoolers can earn one college credit while being immersed in both the Spanish language and culture. Includes daily excursions around *Sevilla* as well as an excursion to *Cádiz*.

Professional Development: Looking for professional development opportunities for yourself? We would love to have you join us for our summer terms in *Sevilla*. Spend four to eight weeks next summer at our school, TCCSevilla, immersing yourself in the Spanish language and culture, with the option to live with a host family.
