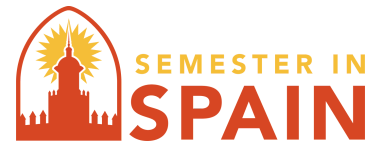


Verano Sevillano 2025

A two-week immersive experience for high school groups.



Dates:

Arrive in *Sevilla* on Monday, June 16th. Depart from *Sevilla* on Saturday, June 28th.

What's included:

- One college credit from Trinity Christian College
- Housing
- Three meals per day
- Courses materials
- Group excursions to *Granada* (overnight) and *Cádiz* (day trip)
- Linens
- Wi-Fi
- Cultural activities in *Sevilla*
- Transportation to and from the airport
- Health insurance
- Fees covered for one chaperone for every six students from your school

What is not included?

Airfare to and from *Sevilla*, souvenirs, etc.

Requirements:

Students must have completed two years of high school Spanish or have similar heritage Spanish speaker proficiency.

Fees per student and additional chaperones (minimum of six students per school): \$4500

Next steps:

- November 1 - \$1000 Consultation & Administration fee and signed proposal due.
- February 1 - Send list of confirmed students and their Spanish proficiency levels .
- March 1 - Trinity Christian College provides invoice to your school.
- April 1 - Payment due in full (no refunds after May 1).
