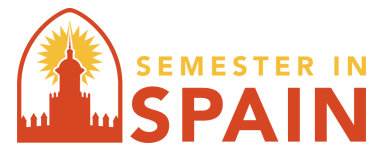


Verano Sevillano

A two-week immersive experience for high school groups.



Dates:

Final two weeks of June, typically arriving on a Monday and departing on a Saturday.

What's included:

- College credit: SIS 207 (1) Cultura Española
- Cultural activities in *Sevilla*
- Group excursions in *Andalucía*
 - *Granada* (overnight)
 - *Cádiz* (day trip)
- Housing (includes all linens and wifi)
- Three meals per day
- Transportation to and from the airport
- Student health insurance
- Fees covered for one chaperone for every six students from your school

What is not included?

Airfare to and from *Sevilla*, souvenirs, some snacks, purchases for personal needs, etc.

Requirements:

Students must have completed two years of high school Spanish or have similar heritage Spanish speaker proficiency.

- November 1 - \$1000 Consultation & Administration fee and signed proposal due.
- February 1 - Send list of confirmed students and their Spanish proficiency levels.
