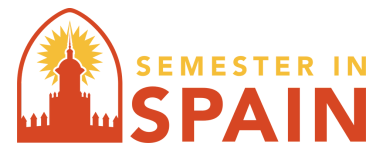


# Verano Sevillano

## What's included

## What is not included

Airfare to and from *Sevilla*, souvenirs, local phone plan.

## Requirements

Students must have completed two years of high school Spanish or have similar heritage Spanish speaker proficiency.

## Fees per student and additional chaperones

\$3,100 per student. One chaperone fee waived for every six students enrolled.

## Next steps

- November 5 - \$1000 Consultation & Administration fee and signed proposal due.
- February 4 - Send list of confirmed students and their Spanish proficiency levels.
- March 4 - Trinity Christian College provides invoice to your school.
- April 1 - Payment due in full (no refunds after May 1).
