

Semester in Spain Student FAQs

Preguntas más frequentes de estudiantes



How many credits can I earn when I study abroad?

A semester is 16 weeks. There are two, four-week terms in summer. Students can participate multiple semesters and in both Term 1 and 2 should they choose.



Are classes taught in Spanish or Engligh?

No. Host families are committed to preparing students three meals a day, seven days a week. Cost is included in room & board fee.



Will I have insurance coverage while studying abroad?

Students often are placed with a roommate. All homestay families are vetted. To request single placement, there is an an additional fee.



What if I have a food allergy, sensitivity or intolerance?

Student spending varies. We recommend students budget and save for costs not covered by the program like personal travel, eating out, attending local festivals, events y más.



How much free time will I have for personal use and travel?

Students come from a variety of universities. The majority are from institutions affiliated with the Coalition of Christian Colleges & Universities (CCCU).

For a **semester** students can earn **12-18 credits**. For a **summer** students can earn **4-6 credits**, per four-week term.

How long is a semester? How long is a summer?



The language of instruction is always Spanish. All classes, coursework, excursions y más utilize the language.

Will I need to meal plan while studying abroad?



Yes. All students have robust medical, dental and mental health insurance. Students also have access to free online counseling. *Cost is included in tuition fee.*

Will I have a roommate or will I live on my own?



Students will list these on their application. The program can accommodate vegetarian, pescatarian, gluten free, lactose free and egg free. These are an additional cost.

How much money should I plan to save for when I study abroad?



Students can expect weekends to be available. Semester students will be given a week long break from classes.

Spanish holidays are also built into the calendar.
