



Semester in Spain Student FAQs

Semester in Spain (SIS) is a study abroad program in Sevilla promoting immersive learning, intercultural engagement, & inclusive Christian community.



How many credits can I earn when I study abroad?

A fall or spring **semester is 16 weeks**. In summer, there are two **four-week terms**. *Students can participate in multiple semesters and both Term 1 and 2 should they choose.*

For a **semester** students can earn **12-18 credits**. For a **summer** students can earn **4-6 credits** per four-week term.

Are classes taught in Spanish or English?

No. Host families are committed to preparing students three meals a day, seven days a week. *Cost is included in room & board.*

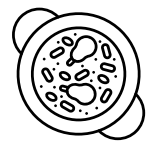
The language of instruction is always Spanish. All classes, coursework, excursions y más utilize the language. Intermediate or Advanced sequence offered.



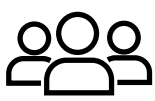
What if I have a food allergy, sensitivity or intolerance?

Students are often placed with a roommate from the program. All homestay families are vetted. *To request single placement, there is an additional fee.*

Will I need to meal plan while studying abroad?



Students must list these on their application so host families can accommodate.



Who will I be studying abroad with?

Students are encouraged to ask their study abroad office; every school approaches this differently. *Excludes airfare to and from Spain.*

Will I have a roommate or will I live on my own?



Students come from a variety of universities. The majority are from institutions affiliated with the Council for Christian Colleges & Universities (CCCU).



How much spending money should I take?

Students can expect **weekends** to be available. Semester students will be given a **week long break** from classes. **Spanish holidays** are also built into the calendar.

How much does the program cost?



Student spending varies. We recommend students budget and save for costs not covered by the program like personal travel, eating out, attending local festivals, events y más.
